

Upcoming Construction Activities Summer 2018

- 10 PM June 1 – 5 AM June 4**
 - Weekend closure of I-35W between I-94 and Hwy 62
 - Reason: Demolition of 26th Street bridge and 24th Street pedestrian bridge
- June 1**
 - Franklin Ave bridge reopens to only pedestrians, bicyclists and emergency vehicles
- June 1 – Early Nov. 2018**
 - 26th Street bridge closed
- June 1 – Fall 2021**
 - 24th Street pedestrian bridge closed
- 10 PM June 8 – 5 AM June 11**
 - Weekend closure of I-94 between I-394 and I-35W and access to/from downtown and I-35W
 - Reason: Demolition of road to/from downtown and I-35W and ramp from east I-94 to south I-35W
- June 8 – Fall 2018**
 - Access from north I-35W to downtown (11th St/Grant St/5th Ave) closed
 - Ramp from north I-35W to 31st St/Lake St closed (open to transit/emergency vehicles); will close again in fall 2020
- June 8 – Fall 2021**
 - Access from downtown (12th St/4th Ave) closed (Fall 2018: access will reopen to transit buses)
 - Ramp from east I-94 to south I-35W closed
 - Ramp from 31st Street to south I-35W closed (open to transit/emergency vehicles June 8–Fall 2018)
- Mid-June**
 - Franklin Ave bridge reopens to motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians
- 10 PM June 15 – 5 AM June 18**
 - Weekend closure of I-35W between I-94 and Hwy 62
 - Reason: Restriping of I-35W lanes to shift lanes and open areas for reconstruction activities
- June 15 – Summer 2019**
 - North I-35W: Three lanes open (one lane MnPASS)
 - South I-35W: Two lanes open
- June 15 – Fall 2020**
 - Ramp from south I-35W to 35th Street closed
- June 15 – Fall 2021**
 - Ramp from 35th Street to north I-35W closed
- Early Aug. 2018**
 - 38th Street bridge reopens to motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians
- Early Aug. 2018 – Fall 2020**
 - 40th Street pedestrian bridge closed
